RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRIES: Entries must be emailed to SBFshows@gmail.com. There will be a post entry fee of \$25 per horse/rider entry if entered after November 29th at 6:00 PM. No numbers will be issued without an open check & signed release. Current coggins must be presented to the horse show office for all horses on the grounds. Please note barn affiliation on entry form and check.

SCHOOLING: Ticketed schooling available Saturday after 3pm, \$35 per horse. Sunday schooling Ring 1 6:30-7:30, Ring 2 daybreak to 7:30, 7:30- 7:45 poles only schooling. A fee of \$50 per horse will be charged for any horse schooling, but not showing on Sunday.

FEES: Individual Classes are \$20 each. \$35 office/EMT/prize/USHJA fee. A fee of \$15 will be applied to any open checks not closed by the end of the day.

RETURNED CHECKS: A \$25.00 fee will be charged for all returned checks.

DOGS: There will be NO DOGS on the property that are not attached by a leash to a person's hand!!!

ATTIRE: SEI APPROVED HELMETS MUST BE WORN BY ALL RIDERS WHILE MOUNTED. Half chaps and paddock boots are acceptable. Warm clothes are welcome on cold days. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible.

RIBBONS, TROPHIES, and CHAMPIONSHIP: All classes receive a prize and 6 ribbons. All Divisions will be awarded Champion and Reserve ribbons using the standard tally system: 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, 1/2. In the event of a tie, management will break the tie by over fences points. Champion rosette and trophy will be awarded and Reserve rosettes. Divisions must have a minimum of 3 competitors in all classes to qualify for champion/reserve ribbons and prizes. Warm Up classes do not count towards champion and reserve prizes.

FOOTING: Ring 1: 135 X 250 arena with custom Kiser footing / Ring 2: 100 X 200 Sand. Warm up ring is a fenced grass area.

CHANGES: Management reserves the right to change schedule, cancel or combine classes, alter courses, and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries. Divisions with less than 3 entries may be cancelled or combined.

RESPONSIBILITY: Submission of entry to these shows constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Spellbound Farm and USHJA officials against any claim, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fee for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or it's use of the premises or from any breach on the part of Exhibitors of an conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invitees in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding by council acceptable to owner. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property and Spellbound Farm and USHJA Management is not responsible for accidents, fire, or theft.

Cross Entries: Horse/rider combination may cross enter only into divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference

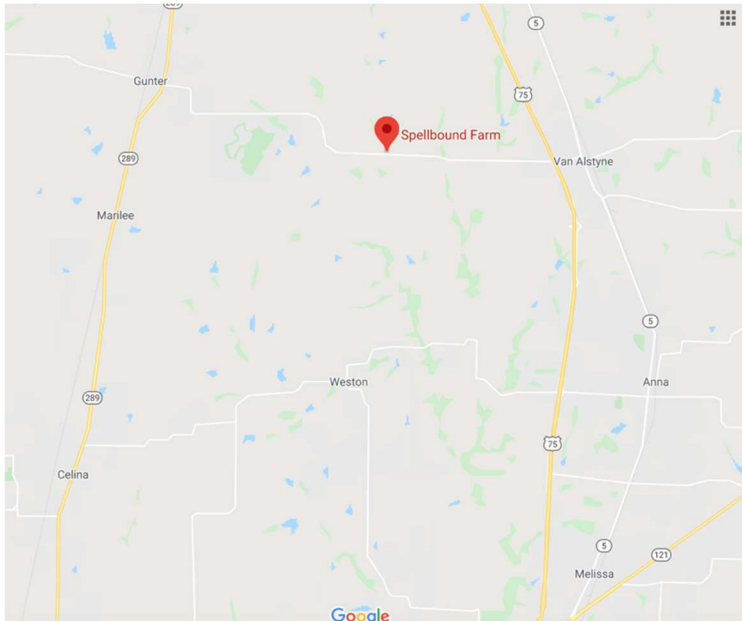

End of Series Awards!

Champion in each division will receive a special ribbon and prize.

Reserve champion in each division will receive a special ribbon.

A division must have had 3 or more entries in each class in at least 2 of the 3 shows to qualify for series end awards.

Points for all hunter and jumper divisions will track by the horse, different riders are allowed. Points for all equitation divisions will follow the rider. A horse or rider must compete in all classes of each division (warm-up not required and does not count for points) in at least 2 of the 3 shows to qualify for series end awards.

Awards will be given out at the last show of the series. Anyone receiving awards not in attendance at that show may schedule to pick up their awards another time or have another person pick them up from the show. Awards will not be mailed.
